It's a true fact that as part human beings we are easily adaptable and receptive to those around us. And as you have probably already heard the saying goes 'show me your company and ill show you who you are'. It is imperative that we encourage our children to associate with those who are radiating positive vibes and have a real love for all that is life. Although we can not choose their friends for them we can raise our children to acknowledge bad behaviour and unhealthy habits.

There will come a time when they may want to experiment in some slightly peculiar activities but as long as they have a strong grip of reciprocal action known as karma. They will think twice when engaging in such things for any prolonged length of time. It is important for them to

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have goals and aspirations from a young age where they can join or create clubs to socialise with others who share the same interests. Children will always model those around them mirroring accents body language and even attitude. It's how we as part humans relate to one and other to communicate, show understanding and empathy amongst our groups.

There are no guarantees for how our children will turn out, but I do believe that when they are given the correct tools, motivation and morals they will be a success at whatever they do. Well equipped to deal with any problems or challenges they may face along the way.

Teenagers

When your child becomes a young person they will tend to be guided by peers and those who they share common interests with. As a result they are less likely to feel that adults truly understand what they are going through. We as carers and parents can only plant the seed and nurture it with our best efforts love and light, but there comes a point when we have to trust that our great care and attention will manifest beautiful crop. Instead of trying endlessly to battle with a hormonal teenager I suggest letting out the reigns with the belief that the morals and values you have instilled them with will bode them well in the rest of their development. focus on.

Loving another isn't expecting them to be who you are or indeed how you would want them to be. No, Love is about awareness and acceptance. Knowing that each of us are completely different and exactly the same and allowing others to be who they are without passing judgements or criticizing, Parents must realise that although we would love our young to learn everything from the mistakes we have made, 99% of the time they won't. Life is about experiences and taking risks; children must take the ultimate journey alone surrounded by loving and

supportive guardians.
